

Bury St Edmunds Magna Carta Barons' Prize Trail 2015

(the '**Competition**')

The Competition Rules (the '**Rules**'):

1. The Competition shall be jointly organised, administered and judged by (without limitation):
 - a. The Bury St Edmunds Magna Carta 800 Committee;
 - b. The Bury St Edmunds Round Table;
 - c. Our Bury St Edmunds;
 - d. The Bury Free Press;
 - e. St Edmundsbury Cathedral; and
 - f. Bury in Bloom,(together being referred to as the '**Organisers**').
2. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel or amend the Competition or the Rules without notice.
3. The decision of the Organisers shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
4. The address you provide with your Competition entry (the '**Entry**' or '**Entries**') may be used to send any prizes so please make sure this is correct.
5. Employees or members of the Organisers and their immediate families are not eligible to win any prizes in the Competition.
6. The Organisers assume that by entering the Competition (and the entrant warrants that) the entrant is aged 18 or over or, if the entrant is under 18, that the entrant's parents have consented to the Entry into the Competition and these Rules.
7. The Organisers reserve the right to disqualify any entrant if they have reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the Rules.
8. Only one Entry per person is allowed and any entrant who submits more than the permitted maximum may be disqualified, at the Organisers discretion. Where a winner has been selected and the Organisers discover or have reasonable grounds to believe the winner has made more than one Entry, the Organisers reserve the right to select an alternative winner. Any further winner will be selected on the same criteria as the original winner and will be subject to these Rules.
9. There is no charge or purchase required to enter the Competition.
10. Competition Entries must be completed in the manner specified on the Entry form, which can be collected from the St Edmundsbury Cathedral Tourist Information Point. Competition

Entries must be received by the Organisers at the St Edmundsbury Cathedral Tourist Information Point by the closing date stated on the Entry form. Failure to do so may disqualify the Entry.

11. Proof of posting or delivery cannot be accepted as proof of receipt by the Organisers.
12. Entrants should note that unless stated otherwise, the Organisers do not accept responsibility for the return of any Entries, including those consisting of artistic or other material.
13. Prize winners will be chosen at random from all correct qualifying Entries within 28 days of the closing date specified on the Entry form. In all matters, the decision of the Organisers shall be final and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into.
14. Prize winners will be promptly notified by the Organisers. Return of any prize notification as undeliverable or failure to reply as specified in the notification (and within the time stated) may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner. Only one prize per entrant will be awarded.
15. The Organisers reserve the right to request written proof of age of any winner.
16. In consideration of the Organisers agreeing to consider entrants to the Competition, each entrant hereby agrees that their name, age and Entry may be used and published on the Organisers' websites, in their publications and in the wider press, publications or online. Should photographs of Competition winners be taken with their consent, such photographs may also be used and published on the Organisers' websites, in their publications and in the wider press, publications or online.
17. Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. The Organisers reserve the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value at any time.
18. Prizes are awarded at the discretion of the Organisers and no prizes will be awarded as a result of improper actions by or on behalf of any entrant.
19. The Organisers cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrant entering the Competition or as a result of accepting any prize. Nothing shall exclude the Organisers' liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.
20. Any personal data relating to entrants will not be disclosed to a third party without the individual's consent. Data relating to entrants will be retained by the Organisers for a reasonable period after the Competition closes to assist the Organisers in dealing with any queries connected to the Competition.
21. The Competition and Rules will be governed by English law and any dispute will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
